

Looking back to Arnisdale with Beinn Sgritheall behind

This year the swallows left before we were ready to see them go, and late summer has turned into a mellow and then rather wet and windy autumn. Already the temperature has dropped low enough for a frost, and deer can be heard roaring again from the islands.

This year we've explored some more fabulous places around Scotland. In March, from our base at Glenelg, we were looking out at fresh snow on the mountains of Skye while the partly-eclipsed moon set behind the hills. We ventured down towards Arnisdale and explored the two extraordinary Iron Age brochs in Gleann Beag.

In April we were listening to the first corncrakes calling on lona, while making our way down towards St Columba's Bay at the southern end of the island. And then in July we were right up on the north coast at Durness, looking for wild flowers - in particular Primula scotica, the Scottish primrose, which Colin was particularly keen to find. You can see some of the results of this little plant hunting trip in this newsletter.




'October Mist' Ever-changing light and low cloud create some of the most beautiful effects over snow covered mountains. This time of year deer are surprisingly hard to spot.








Plant-hunting in Sutherland yielded some stunning surprises, more than we could have dared to hope. Beneath Scots pines by Loch Fleet we were enchanted to discover one-flowered wintergreen, also known as 'frog's reading lamp,' and the delicate twinflower, both thriving on the shady woodland floor.

Moving on to Durness, we explored sand dunes rich in orchids, and rocky outcrops covered with alpine species. We eventually tracked down frog orchid and mountain avens, and on our last day we were thrilled to find the diminutive Scottish primrose. What a wild and uncompromising landscape, and we can't wait to return.
